

Saddle Up for the Cure Trail Ride Rules

- 1. Safety of all participants and horses is of primary importance.
- 2. Proof of negative Coggins must be presented at arrival.
- 3. No stallions will be permitted.
- 4. Anyone 18 and under must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.
- 5. Quiet generators are welcome.
- 6. Trail courtesy is expected.
- 7. Alcohol on the trail is not permitted.
- 8. The use of illegal drugs is prohibited and the discovery of such will result in notification of local law enforcement agencies.
- 9. "Leave no Trace" protocol will be followed. Please do not litter on the trail. If you take it on the trail, please take it out, including cigarettes.
- 10. Please refrain from smoking around other guests in common areas. Smoking is not allowed under the food and entertainment tent. Cigarettes should be disposed of properly and not thrown on the ground, including on the trail.
- 11. Keep dogs on a leash and under control at all times within the camp area.
- 12. Quiet time is from 11:00 pm 6:00 am.
- 13. No rider age 18 or younger participating in any Saddle Up for the Cure function shall use any hard-and-fast restraint equipment to secure themselves to their equine and/or saddle in any manner.
- 14. Please do not pony riderless horses on the trail, unless in an emergency situation.
- 15. Please keep your horse at a walk at all times within the camp area.
- 16. ATV's, motorbikes, mopeds or bicycles will not be allowed in the camp area or on the trail, except for use by Saddle Up for the Cure crew.
- 17. Please be respectful to all attendees and refrain from unruly and/or obnoxious behavior.
- 18. All camp areas must be clean before leaving them.
- 19. Riders are responsible for cleaning up manure and hay from the area around their trailer and camp site. Manure and hay should be scattered prior to departure..
- 20. The use of helmets is encouraged, especially for minor riders.
- 21. Neither The American Cancer Society nor Trace Trails be responsible for accidents or theft.
- 22. Saddle Up for the Cure crew, American Cancer Society staff, Trace Trails staff/property owners reserve the right to require attendees to leave the premises, without a refund, should rules not be followed.
